

Bucksnag Hunting Club Coronavirus Operational Plan and Protocol

General:

- Each member or guest will be required to complete and sign a questionnaire and release, which must be completed affirmatively prior to arrival. Members need to police themselves and their guests in advance to assure questionnaire answers will not result in someone being turned away at the door.
- All employees, members and guests must wear a face covering (over the nose and mouth), except within lodging rooms, when eating or drinking or if outdoors and acceptable distancing can be maintained.
- Kitchen and Manager's office will be off limits to members and guests at all times.
- In all events, Club operations will comply with Texas laws and orders and incorporated CDC guidelines.

Bar and Appetizers:

- Bar and bar area will be closed other than access to the beer and soft drink cooler and closets where members store and can access their alcohol.
- Each group will have a bar/dining area designated for its use before arrival, with the member booking that group responsible for providing an ice chest and filling it from the ice machine, and otherwise stocking the group's designated area.
- Appetizers will be provided in individual single serving portions at each designated area.

Dining:

- Dining tables will be spaced throughout the clubhouse to enable social distancing.
- Groups to maintain generally at least 6 feet of distance from other groups at all times.
- Tables will generally be at least 6 feet apart from any part of another table.
- No tables of more than 10 people.
- No unused silverware, glassware or similar items will be left on an unoccupied table.
- Condiments will be provided for each group's use and removed and cleaned afterward.

Facilities:

- Employees, members and guests will be screened for fever and other symptoms. Any employee, member or guest exhibiting symptoms or who cannot respond affirmatively to the questionnaire will be sent home. New arrivals will not be permitted before 4:30 p.m. to accommodate screening and collection of paper work. Questionnaires and releases will be filed in a daily register to allow for contact tracing if necessary.
- 6 feet social distancing should be maintained as possible between individual guests and staff, between guests and personal use items such as clean glassware, and between groups.
- Regularly touched surfaces, such as doorknobs, tables and chairs will be regularly and frequently cleaned and disinfected.
- Commonly used restrooms will be regularly and frequently cleaned.
- Hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes will be readily available and should be used frequently, and always before and after touching commonly used facilities, such as the beer and soda cooler or ice machine.
- Lodging rooms will be cleaned and disinfected after each group of guests departs. Lodging rooms will not be cleaned while occupied.
- Kitchen/dining areas will be cleaned and sanitized after each meal service.

Hunting:

- No groups larger than 10 individuals. When possible, individuals should minimize in-person contact, including 6 feet of separation and/or wearing masks.
- Staggered times for groups or separate departure areas should be provided if possible.
- Guests must bring their own equipment – no sharing or community equipment to be used.
- Each member is responsible for transporting his or her group to the field and determining any sharing of vehicles among passengers and related vehicle sanitation.
